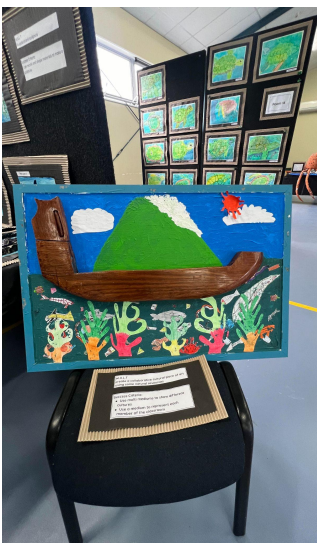
## Volleyball
